Overview

Atypik Places is a collaborative platform that brings together, in one place, the venues, services and professionals genuinely suited to neurodivergent people (ADHD, autism, dyslexia and related, giftedness) and their loved ones, across France, Belgium and Switzerland.

The approach is simple: start from real needs rather than diagnosis. Each venue can be searched by concrete criteria — sensory atmosphere, quietness, lighting, quality of welcome — and relies on multi-criteria reviews from the community.

Our mission

To help every neurodivergent person confidently find a place or a professional that matches their real needs — through the sensory experience, the welcome and lived experience, never through a diagnosis. To make access to information simpler, more visible and deeply human.

Faceted search by sensory needs and multi-criteria community reviews.

A directory of neurodiversity-aware professionals, with detailed profiles.

- **Classifieds**

A space for mutual help and small ads between concerned individuals.

- **Screening tests**

Informative questionnaires to better understand oneself and get oriented.

- **Le coin love**

A caring dating space reserved for adults, built around respect, consent and attentive moderation.

- **Editorial resources**

Clear, sensitive articles and content tailored to real needs.
